

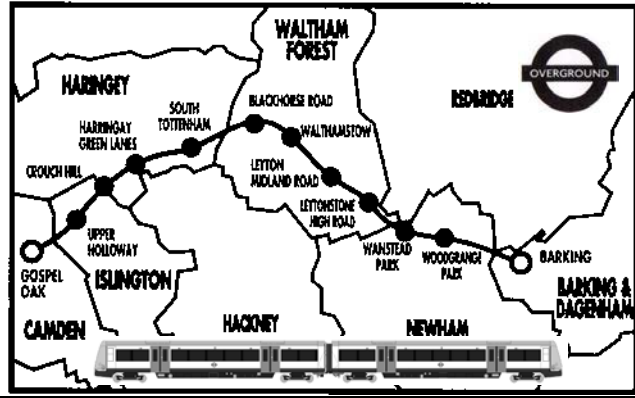

However, **Greater Anglia services via
Seven Sisters, Tottenham Hale & Walthamstow** are disrupted

Those wanting to travel this holiday weekend will find that they are able to roam the full length of the Barking – Gospel Oak Line as well as the rest of the London Overground network. If planning to travel further afield, check our holiday weekend round up of rail and underground services in North East London, especially those wanting to use Greater Anglia's West Anglia service group and First Capital Connect's services through Haringay.

Barking – Gospel Oak Line passengers have several events within easy reach of stations just “down the line”

- **Kew Gardens (change on to a Richmond train at Gospel Oak)** Kew Gardens are launching their Chocolate Quest event on Good Friday with an Easter Egg hunt on Easter Sunday. The whole event is on until 14 April.
- **Hampstead Heath/Parliament Hill Fields (Gospel Oak)** The traditional Easter Fair will be on at both upper and lower fairgrounds over all four days. There will be an Easter Egg hunt at the adventure playground at 2pm on Bank Holiday Monday.
- **Markfield Beam Engine Museum (South Tottenham)** Crowland Road The museum will be open on Bank Holiday Monday and the beam engine will be in steam.
- **Brooks City Farm in Skeltons Lane Park** A short walk from Leyton Midland Road, the farm will be open on Easter Sunday and Bank Holiday Monday.

BARKING - GOSPEL OAK LINE

The next planned engineering block age will between Barking and South Tottenham on Sunday 14 April until 12:15. Valid rail tickets will be accepted on the rail replacement bus service. See posters on stations or ask staff for further information.

The next planned engineering blockage will be between Sydenham and Crystal Palace on Sunday 7 April.

EUSTON – WATFORD JUNCTION LOCAL (DC LINES) SERVICE

The next planned engineering blockage will be on Sunday 21 April between Kilburn High Road and Euston.

NORTH LONDON LINE

Note that buses replace LUL Jubilee Line trains between West Hampstead and Stanmore 29 March – 1 April.

The next engineering blockage will be between Camden Road and Willesden Junction on Sunday 21 April until 11:00.

WEST LONDON LINE

Valid rail tickets will be accepted on any reasonable TfL London Buses routes to stations between Seven Sisters and Liverpool Street.

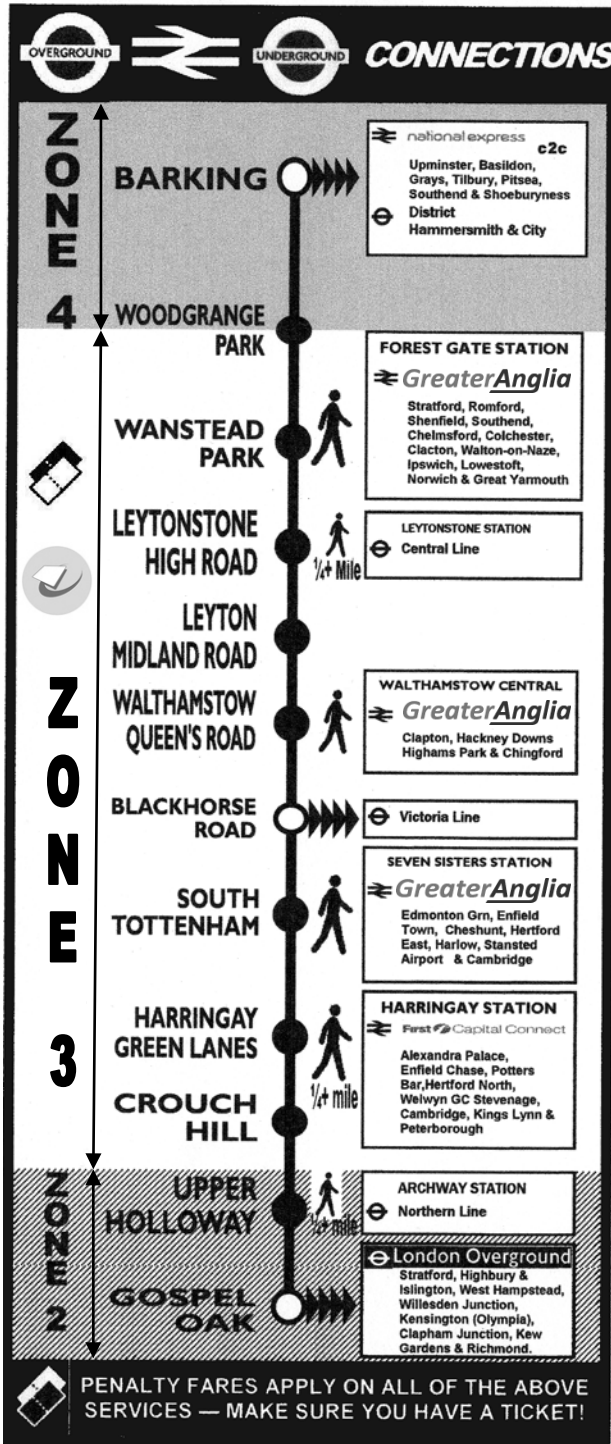
Tottenham Hale: Services to/from Hertford East (except Sunday)/Stansted Airport/Cambridge will be diverted via Stratford to/from Liverpool Street.

Walthamstow: No service between Chingford and Liverpool Street. Valid rail tickets will be accepted on the rail replacement bus service between Walthamstow Central and Chingford and on TfL London Buses routes to stations between Walthamstow Central and Liverpool Street.
